Corpus Christi is pleased to have Fr. Anthony Obada from the Diocese of Ilorin in Nigeria, who will be speaking at all the Masses next weekend, June 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. The Catholic Diocese of Ilorin was erected a prefecture on January 20, 1960 and became a diocese on May 29, 1969. Bishop Ayo-Maria Atoyebi, OP, is the present bishop with Bishop Paul Olawoore as its co-adjutor. There are more than 25, 865 Catholics, more than 235 religious and at least 51 priests. The diocese has clinics, schools and a propaedeutic seminary. They exist in a predominately Moslem part of Nigeria and are grateful to God for the harmony that exists. 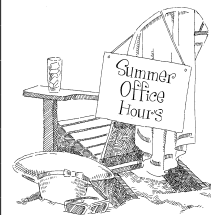
### Congratulations to the Class of 2019!

**Gospel** -- Jesus Christ appears to the disciples and sends them on their mission (John 20:19-23).

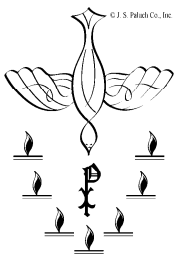
**The Day of the Holy Spirit!**

**J**ohn's Gospel tells us that when Jesus "breathed" on the disciples, the Holy Spirit came into them, empowering them to forgive sins and to gather all people into union with one another.

**T**he book of Genesis had explained the divisions among nations with the story of the Tower of Babel. In rebellious pride, human beings had struggled to become equal to God. The result was chaos, strife, the inability even to speak the same language among themselves. Today's reading from Acts tells how the Spirit has just the opposite effect. Strangers from many nations hear and understand one another, each in his or her own tongue.

**T**his message of unity in the Spirit is repeated in the reading from Corinthians. There are many gifts, many ways to serve. One way is not "higher," nor one person "better" than another. There is but one Spirit, who accomplishes all the different works we do, acting through us.

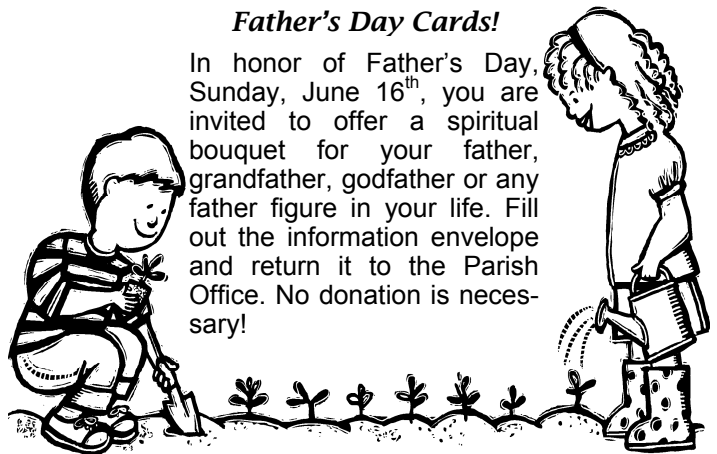
**Magnificat Prayer Breakfast!**
