I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

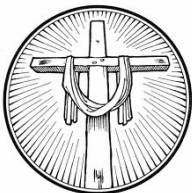
**I love You above all things

Amen.**

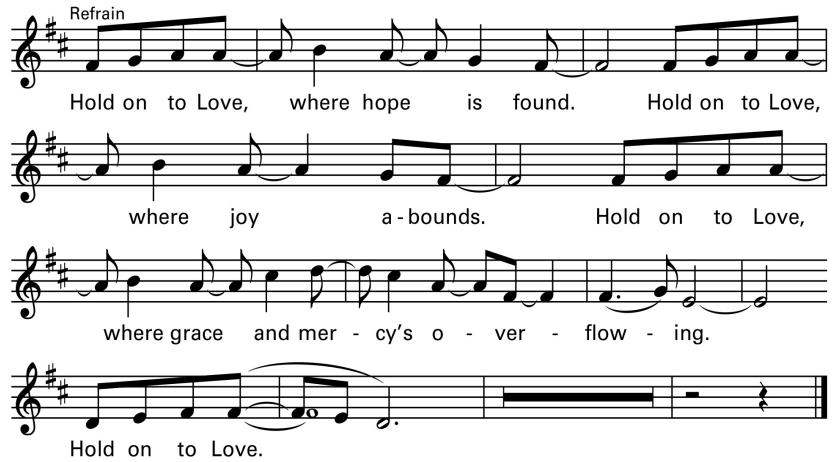
