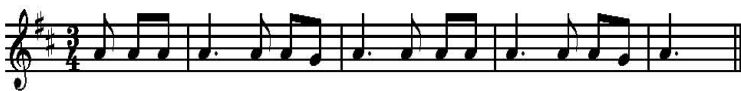
Here in this time, here in this place,
