OCW and St. Mary's staff indicated we could best be of service if we provided gift cards for each recipient. They asked that gift cards be in the amount of **\$25** and that the gift cards come from Target or Walmart (OCW recipients) or Target (St. Mary's recipients) as these are the stores that are conveniently located to the individuals who are served.

On our Giving Tree, you will find an ornament for each OCW or St. Mary's recipient. We ask that you take one (or more) ornament(s) from the tree and **return each ornament with a \$25 gift card** from Target or Walmart **attached to the ornament**.

We will collect gift cards after all masses on the weekends of: **November 30th/December 1st, December 7th/8th and December 14/15th**. You may also drop off cards during the week in the rectory mailbox. Please be sure to attach the ornament(s), as well!

Or if you normally donate electronically simply follow the procedure you use with your bank and add *Christmas Giving Tree* to the memo line. **All checks must be received by December 15th** so that we can purchase the gift cards in time.
