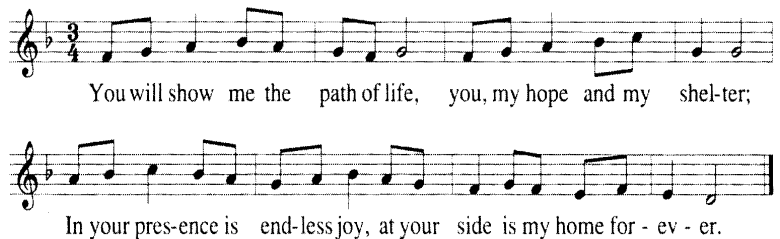
Acts 2:14 22-33

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven,
raised his voice, and proclaimed:
"You who are Jews, indeed all of you staying in
Jerusalem. Let this be known to you, and listen to my
words. You who are Israelites, hear these words.
Jesus the Nazarene was a man commended to you by
God with mighty deeds, wonders, and signs,
which God worked through him in your midst, as you
yourselves know. This man, delivered up by the set plan
and foreknowledge of God, you killed, using lawless men
to crucify him. But God raised him up, releasing him
from the throes of death, because it was impossible for
him to be held by it. For David says of him:
*I saw the Lord ever before me,
with him at my right hand I shall not be disturbed.
Therefore my heart has been glad and my tongue has
exulted; my flesh, too, will dwell in hope, because you
will not abandon my soul to the netherworld,
nor will you suffer your holy one to see corruption.
