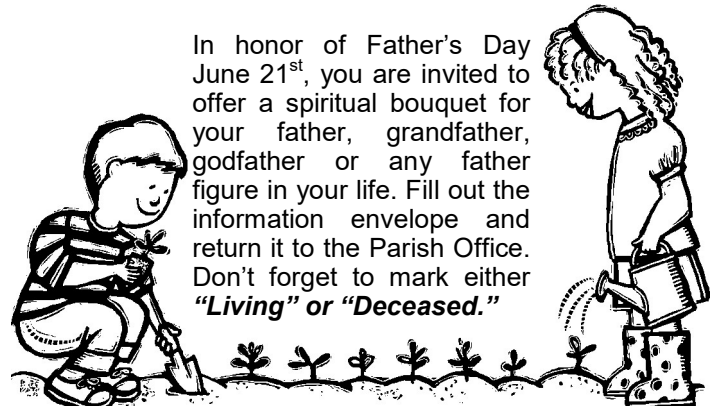
**Today's Readings**
